Information for all Applicants

Please submit your application as one PDF (max. 18 pages, 10 MB) to <u>leibniz-eega@ifl-leipzig.de</u> and consider the following notes for the specific funding measures the EEGA provides.

Postdoc Grants for Preparation of Funding Applications

- Funding period: min. 1 month to max. 6 months
- individual scholarship of 1.750 Euros per month¹ (not be used to supplement grants from other funding organizations or income from employment)
- Scholarship holders are asked to conceptualize, write and finalize a funding application for submission at a national or international science foundation

The application must include:

- 1. EEGA Application Form
- 2. CV (incl. Publication List)
- 3. Discussion of potential funding institutions for the envisaged research project (100 300 words)

Postgraduate-Grants (Preparation of PhD)

- Funding period: 3 months
- individual scholarship of 750 Euros per month
- Eligible are postgraduate students only (the submission of the MA thesis should not date back longer than 12 months)

The application must include:

- 1. EEGA Application Form
- 2. CV
- Abstract (250 500 words), field of research and 5 keywords describing the intended PhD project
- 4. Letter of reference

Short-term Stays for Guest Scholars in Leipzig, Halle and Jena

- Funding period: min. 4 days to max. 4 weeks
- short-term fellowship: rates are related to the duration of the stay and calculated to the day
- Eligible are scholars at the Postdoc-level from the region, but also senior researchers from other countries who are active in the fields of Eastern European Studies, European Studies,

Global and Area Studies, and the disciplines involved in the EEGA referring to Eastern Europe's changing role in current and historical processes of globalisation.

- We welcome proposals for short stays for
 - a) guest lectures or other teaching formats in the MA- and PhD-programmes affiliated with the EEGA,
 - b) workshops and networking meetings with junior and senior scholars in the EEGA, and
 - c) collaboration in joint publication projects.

The application (1 PDF with max. 10 pages) must include:

- 1. EEGA Application Form
- 2. CV (incl. Publication List)

Thematic Workshops and Conferences

- Eligible to submit proposals for thematic workshops and conferences (including thematic writing retreats and discussion fora) are Postdocs from EEGA member institutions and their cooperation partners.
- Individual funding: ranging from either full funding of costs for travel, accommodation, honoraria, catering, equipment and room rent for the workshop, or partial subsidies for events that have secured funding elsewhere but require smaller financial supplements
- Co-operation with Postdocs from Eastern Europe institutions are highly welcome

The application must include:

- 1. EEGA Application Form
- 2. CVs (of main organisers)
- 3. Calculation of expected costs
