

Plagiarism declaration

I declare that I understand that plagiarism is a dishonest act that is essentially theft and fraud. Therefore, it is imperative that the work I submit properly and clearly identifies the ideas and words of others, which will be clearly separated from my own ideas and words.

I, therefore, understand that it is not acceptable:

- to submit a text written (in whole or in part) by another author (including a student) in any language and claim it to be my own;
- to use another author's text verbatim (even if translated from a foreign language) without acknowledging the source (proper citation) and distinguishing it graphically from one's own text, e.g. by using quotation marks, italics, etc.;
- to paraphrase part of another author's text (in any language) without citing a source that clearly distinguishes it from my own;
- to reproduce the ideas or arguments of another author's text (including ideas and arguments in other languages) without acknowledging the source;
- to use facts, data, statistics, maps, illustrations, etc. without citing the source if they are the result of someone else's work;
- to take work originally produced for an assignment by one teacher and resubmitting it to another teacher to fulfil the requirements of another course;
- to ask another writer to produce a text on my behalf, or allow others to revise the material to such an extent that the resulting text is largely the result of their work and not mine;
- to use artificial intelligence tools or other text creation or editing tools to produce a commissioned work without proper attribution;
- to obtain text for payment from any source and submit it as my own.

I understand that my actions in violation of the above will constitute a violation of the Study and Examination Code of Palacký University Olomouc and that such actions may result in disciplinary action, which may include termination of study. I shall, therefore, avoid such behaviour.
